Blind from birth and a two-time kidney transplant recipient, **Scott MacIntyre** knows what it means to persevere despite seemingly insurmountable obstacles. From his early days as a classical concert pianist to capturing the hearts of millions of *American Idol* viewers with his engaging presence and vocal prowess, Scott has never let challenges keep him from achieving his dreams. As an accomplished pianist, Scott's heartfelt songs and powerful voice take his audiences on an emotional journey of hardship and hope, entreating listeners that no matter what life brings their way, life is always worth living to the fullest.



Brittany Clayton is a multi-instrumentalist (piano, flute, clarinet, recorders, and voice) jazz artist who also happens to be blind.
